Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you have seen the communications sent home this week regarding the NEU teacher strike action taking place across England on Wednesday and Friday next week. We are closing provision in 4 classes on each day as follows:

If your child is in one of these classes and is entitled to a Free School Meal then you should have also received a letter from school explaining how you can access a meal on that day. Reminder - slips need to be returned to school by MONDAY 3rd July so that food can be ordered - thanks.

Annual Pupils School Reports

Today your child will bring home their final school report of the year. Inside the report pack you will also find a letter explaining some of the staffing arrangements for next year and a smaller slip which indicates which class and teacher your child has been allocated for September 2023 (except Year 6!).

In some year groups, we have taken the decision to mix the classes which is something that we do from time to time. There is an opportunity to come to discuss the content of the report with your child's teacher after school on Thursday next week (6th July). If this is something that you would like then we are asking that you make appointments with the class teacher directly - a letter about this will be coming out on Monday.

Now that your child knows which class they will be in for September, we will be arranging some time for them to be in their new classrooms and meet their new teaching team. These transition sessions will take place in school on w/c 10th July (the week after next).

CURRICULUM NEWS - WHAT HAVE WE BEEN UP TO?

Cosy Cottage

In Cosy Cottage, the children have been learning about volcanoes. They also linked their understanding of a volcanic eruption to their own feelings and emotions. They discussed how our emotions sometimes bubble up inside and eventually explode like that of a volcano. We then learnt different ways how we can prevent this from happening.



Year 2

This week the Year 2 children have been learning about measures in maths. We have been looking at measuring mass, capacity and temperature. We really enjoyed our practical sessions using balance scales to measure the mass of our everyday classroom equipment.



Year 3



This week the children in Year 3 made a visit to Drakes Circus to undertake activities all linked to stories and books. They visited a variety of shops including Fat Face, The Entertainer and Lush. They investigated the goods sold in each of these shops and were given the opportunity to play with some toys and to create their own bath bombs.



Water

Year 3 also visited Waterstones book shop, where they listened to some fantastic stories. They were then given a free book, of their own choosing, to take home with them. What a fantastic shopping experience they had!

Year 5

The children in Year 5 have been learning about natural disasters, as part of their theme Powerful Planet. This week they have been investigating what people do to protect themselves from the impact of earthquakes. They enjoyed designing and building structures that could withstand earthquakes and then testing them to see if their designs were successful. They built different designs using spaghetti and marshmallows and then tested them on very wobbly jelly!
