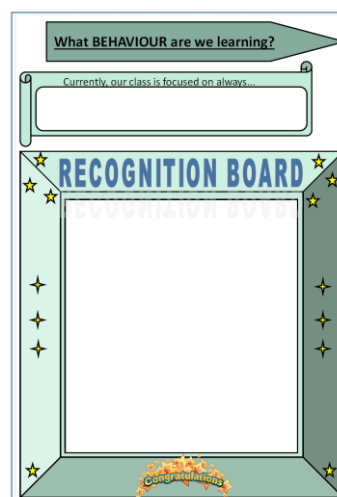
Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and Happy New Year. I hope you and your children had a good break. The children have returned to school, ready for a positive start to 2023 and it has been lovely to see them catching up with each other over the last few days.

## Supporting Positive Behaviour in school

This term, we are having a fresh focus on conduct and behaviour. In September, we introduced our expectation that children are always 'Ready, Respectful and Safe' in school. We believe that good behaviour is recognised sincerely rather than just rewarded. Our approach is to praise children publicly and remind them of our expectations in private.

This week we have introduced 6 clear behaviour Routines that we want the children to consistently practise and use when they are in any area of school:



We have also introduced a recognition board in each classroom so that when staff see the positive behaviours that we expect, the child's name can immediately be added to the board. The children have been really keen to show us their positive behaviours this week and so many children have had their names on our new boards. All staff are proud of the way that the children have engaged with this and children have told us that they enjoy being recognised so frequently. I know that the children will keep this up!
