# Behaviour Approach at Pilgrim - parent and carer meeting invite

As I outlined in a Newsletter earlier in the year, at Pilgrim we have been establishing different approaches to our behaviour support for children, embedding a culture of **Ready**, **Respectful and Safe** rules across school.



We have introduced 6 Keystone routines which are basic behaviours that we expect everyone to show. Children have been introduced to these key behaviours since January and have worked hard in each class to demonstrate these in action. Staff have been keen to spot children across school doing these behaviours, positively recognising those who are showing these behaviours consistently and constantly - there has been lots to celebrate.

We are in the process of updating our guidelines and policies to reflect the changes and we would like to share our new approaches with parents and carers, explaining the fundamentals of the approach and the intended impact. To that end, we are offering a **Behaviour Information Meeting for all parents and carers on Thursday 11th May.** There is a choice of times to attend (you only need to attend one session - it is the same session repeated):

Early Session: 2.30 - 3.15 pm Late Session: 5.15 - 6.00 pm

There is no need to book - just come into school via the reception foyer and join us in the Main Hall - tea, coffee and biscuits will be available. We hope to see many of you there.
