On Tuesday 21st May we visited Living Coasts in Torquay. We watched the seals and penguins being fed and took part in a workshop all about adaptation. It was great!

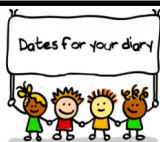


## Year 6

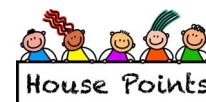
