Pupil Absence

The level of school attendance has been a concern recently, with our worst whole school attendance rate of this academic year last week (95.1%). This time of year, absence can sometimes be caused by illness, coughs and colds. However, I do seem to be getting many requests for holidays during term time, which I am UNABLE TO AUTHORISE. As you know, unacceptable levels of unauthorised or unexplained absence can lead to parents/carers being fined by Plymouth City Council.

I just wanted to clarify the school's duty to inform the Council of pupil absence:

- After 8 sessions (4 days) of unauthorised or unexplained absence, the school is duty bound to report this to Plymouth City Council. A letter will be sent from school to parents/carers to inform them of this.
- If unauthorised or unexplained absence continues, Plymouth City Council will then consider fining parents/carers (**this is an individual fine per child**)
