Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we have welcomed back children from both Year 1 and Year 6. It was lovely to see more groups of children back in school; we currently have about a third of Foundation and Year 1 back in school and nearly half our Year 6 children joining us this week. It is really important to all staff at Pilgrim that the children are happy when they are in school so it has been great to hear so many positive comments from parents and children about their experience of school on their return.

Admissions going forward

All year groups:

Recently, the Government has announced that they **no longer expect that children in ALL year groups** will return to school before the end of the summer term. For the rest of this term, we will focus on how we best meet the needs of those children that are in school and support those that are still home-learning. Therefore, we will only be offering school spaces to those year groups that are currently open: Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6. Schooling for Years 2, 3, 4 & 5 will continue via Google Classroom or the paper learning packs (picked up from school on a fortnightly basis). The Government has now said that they would expect all children to be back in school in September for the start of the next academic year – although the detailed plans about the expectations for September are yet to be announced. I will keep you informed of this changing picture.

Admission to Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6:

On opening Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6 'Bubbles' we contacted every family to ask whether they would like to take up the offer of a place and it has been great that so many families took up that option. However, I know that this decision will have been difficult for all families to make and we are now receiving a few requests for places from families that would now like a space for their child.

The process for making a request for a place would be to telephone our school office and request to put on a waiting list for a place. I would like to make you aware that:

- there will be limited spaces available we have demands on both the amount of space and the amount of staff available whilst respecting the 2m social distance guidelines
- children may have to wait for a space until we have a big enough group to open up a new Bubble (we will not open a Bubble for only 1 child, for example)
- if demand for the limited remaining spaces is high then we will consider only offering part time places and/or use set criteria for admissions (rest assured that children who are already in school full time will continue to be offered full time provision)

Summer Holidays:

At the moment, the Government has not asked schools to make any special arrangements over the school summer holiday period, although I know that this is a real topic of discussion in the media currently. So, to be clear, we are planning for school to **be closed over the summer holiday period in the normal way**. This applies both to classroom/Bubble arrangements and Educare. If this position changes, I will, of course, let you know.
